



Hello!

My name is Maureen, and I am part of the FEMA grant, Covid Recovery Iowa. We have recently been asked to reach out to the counties below, to send out information regarding assistance in Iowa for both the weather disaster and the Covid Pandemic.

“Due to severe weather on Wednesday, July 16th a disaster proclamation has been declared for the following counties: Bremer, Fayette, Winneshiek, Appanoose, Calhoun, Davis, Monroe, Sac and Wapello. Lucas County also remains included for severe weather on June 24th.”

The Iowa Individual Assistance Grant Program can give up to \$5,000 for some eligible households for food, repairs, clothing and other expenses. Residents have 45 days to submit a claim.

Residents can also apply within 180 days for The Disaster Case Management Program that can help residents with disaster-related hardship, injury or adverse conditions. There are no income eligibility requirements for the program.
