A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Early, Iowa was held on the 3rd day of January 2017. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Sharon Ann Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with a roll call as follows: Present: Brian Pickhinke, Doug Gulley, William Cougill, and Mary Ann Brinkman. Absent: Melissa Freese. A motion was made by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Brinkman to approve the consent agenda including; agenda, minutes, and bills for payment. Ayes: Gulley, Cougill, Brinkman, and Pickhinke. Nays: None. Absent: Freese. Motion carried.

Resolution 17-01 – Approving was increases for Full time Employee Maintenance Worker I was offered by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Gulley. On roll call vote. Ayes: Gulley, Pickhinke, Cougill, and Brinkman. Nays: None. Absent: Freese. Whereupon the Mayor declared said resolution duly adopted.
