## City Council News

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Early, Iowa was held on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 2021. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Sharon Ann Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM with roll call as follows: Present: Brian Pickhinke, Bill Cougill, Summer Schmitt, Steven Mason. Absent: Tim Langner. A motion was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Mason to approve the consent agenda including agenda, minutes, bills for payment. On show of hands: Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt, Mason. Motion passed. Parcel owner at 810604117004 approached the council with their past month water bill for negotiation. City has been monitoring their water usage after a staggering high-water usage. The Council approved the City Clerk to adjust the bill to their normal usage and to keep watching their water usage after the new meter and reader have been installed. Anonymous resident wanted to file a complaint on noise ordinance for the neighbor's excessive loud stock car at Parcel-810604103016 that does not stop until right at 10PM. The Council will have the City Clerk send the resident a reminder of the ordinance and being a good neighbor. Municipal Infractions to be sent for city code violations at Parcel-810604010005 and Parcel-810603111013. City will apply for the RENZE Grant to replace/repair South City Sign as it is deteriorating around the wood portions of the sign. A motion was made by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Mason to approve Jim Kunneke to serve on the Planning and Zoning Board. On a show of hands. Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt, Mason. Absent: Langner. Motion passed. Monthly reports were given by the Mayor, Library, Fire Dept, and DPW.

A motion to adjourn was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Cougill. Meeting was adjourned at 8:35 PM.
