# CITY OF EARLY

### City Council News

A Public Hearing was held at 7:00 PM in the council chambers at which time any citizen of Early, Iowa or any other person having interest in the proposed Budget for the fiscal 2022-2023, as published in the Chronicle on February 17th, 2022, or Ordinance 328 Flood Plain as publishing in the Chronicle on February 10th, 2022 may appear, and be heard for or against the adoption of the proposed budget and/or Ordinance 328 or any part thereof. No residents or taxpayers were for or against said Budget and/or Ordinance 328. Hearing was closed. A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Early, Iowa was held on the 1st day of March 2022. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Sharon Ann Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM with roll call as follows: Present: Brian Pickhinke, Bill Cougill, Tim Langner, Summer Schmitt. Absent: Blackman. A motion was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Cougill to approve the consent agenda including agenda, minutes, bills for payment. On show of hands: Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Langner, Schmitt. Motion passed. Resolution 22-07 Adoption of Budget FY 2022-2023 was offered by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Schmitt. On a roll call vote. Aves: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt, Langner. Nays: None. Absent: Blackman. Whereupon the mayor declared said resolution duly adopted. First Reading of Ordinance No. 328 Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Early, Iowa, By Adopting A New Ordinance to Establish Flood Plain Regulations was offered by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Cougill. On a roll call vote. Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt, Langner Nays: None. Absent: Blackman. First reading passed. A motion was made by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Pickhinke to waive the second and third readings. On a show of hands. Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt, Langner. Nays: none. Absent: Blackman. Where upon the Mayor declares the said ordinance duly adopted. A motion was made by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Pickhinke to accept the 28E Agreement with the County Drainage District for DD-59 pending engineering fee clarification on who is to pay. Roll call vote. Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Schmitt. Nays: Langner. Absent: Blackman. Motion passed. A motion was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Schmitt to approve quote from Water Tower Experts for a contract of service to clean and inspect the water tower. On a show of hands. Ayes: Pickhinke, Cougill, Langner, Schmitt. Nays: None. Absent: Blackman. Motion passed. Council discussed Spring Clean-up Day which will be held on May 26th, 2022. The clerk will have further information on what can and cannot be thrown out. The Clerk reported the following receipts and bills that were approved for payment in the consent agenda. Monthly reports were given by the Mayor, Library, Fire Dept, and DPW. A motion was made by Councilor Cougill and seconded by Councilor Pickhinke to close the meeting at 9:00 PM.

### **MAYOR'S NOTES**

After the public hearing the City Council adopted the proposed budget for 2022-2023. Adopted Ordinance 328. This ordinance meets requirements set out by FEMA. There were no changes in the flood plain area as previously set out. Review with the City Attorney the proposed 28E Agreement for Drainage District 59 which has had some revisions made to it following the meeting with the drainage district engineers and the drainage district attorney last month. Council approved the 28E Agreement. Reviewed some proposed changes to the updating of the Code of Ordinances. Iowa Codification will prepare a 1<sup>st</sup> draft. Council needs to review the ordinances for water, sewer, solid waste and recycle rates. Approved the contract for the maintenance of the interior of the water tower. Kris is still getting more information for a new generator for the lagoon. An early heads-up. Citywide clean-up day with be Thursday, May 26.
