

RESOLUTION NO. 21-19

AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 1994 KOMATSU END LOADER WITH ATTACHMENTS, AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE USE OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND AND TRANSFER FROM THE EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, City of Early has authorized Public Works Director to negotiate a purchase agreement for one 1994 Komatsu End Loader with attachments as further described on the attached description, which description is incorporated herein by this reference, and the City should offer the price of \$29,250.00 for said end Loader and authorize the execution of the documents required for the purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City has \$5,000.00 available in the Road Use Tax Fund and \$24,250.00 available in the Equipment Replacement Fund to pay for the purchase of the End Loader; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Iowa Code, a resolution is necessary to transfer \$24,250.00 from the Equipment Replacement Fund to the General Fund and;

WHEREAS, payloader currently owned and used by the City of Early is no longer necessary for city operations and maintenance and should therefore be sold.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Early, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Clerk be and is authorized to transfer the sum of \$24,250.00 from the Equipment Replacement Fund to the General Fund and further authorized to pay \$24,250.00 from the General Fund and \$5,000.00 from the Road Use Tax Fund to Wayne Werner for the acquisition of the End Loader and to do all things necessary in furtherance of the purpose of this resolution.


Section 2. That the City Clerk and City Public Works Director are authorized to sell and convey the payloader currently owned by the City of Early by auction to the highest public bidder.
