City Council News

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Early, Iowa was held on the 5th day of April 2022. The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Sharon Ann Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM with roll call as follows: Present: Brian Pickhinke, Tim Langner, Summer Schmitt, Becky Blackman. Absent: Bill Cougill. A motion was made by Councilor Languer and seconded by Councilor Blackman to approve the consent agenda including agenda, minutes, bills for payment. On show of hands: Ayes: Pickhinke, Langner, Schmitt, Blackman. Motion passed. Citizen Rick Roeder was present and stated that he had purchased a lot within city limits and is making plans for cleanup sometime this summer. He will remove all debris and trailer house from the lot to help expand his business. The Council was grateful and thanked him for helping keep our community beautiful. A motion was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Schmitt to approve building permit #794. On a show of hands: Ayes: Pickhinke, Langner, Schmitt, Blackman. Absent: Cougill. Resolution 22-08 Approving Rudd Sanitation Contract for Solid Waste was offered by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Schmitt. On a roll call vote. Ayes: Pickhinke, Langner, Schmitt, Blackman. Absent: Cougill. Whereupon the mayor declared said resolution duly adopted. A motion was made by Councilor Pickhinke and seconded by Councilor Blackman to approve replacement of three doors on the Municipal Building. On a show of hands. Ayes: Pickhinke, Langner, Schmitt, Blackman. Nays: None. Absent: Cougill. Motion passed. Sheriff Ken McClure presented to the Council with budgeting for the upcoming fiscal year and some possible increases for staffing and other operating expenses. He also reported updates for the radio tower project and that they ran into some land purchasing issues near Schaller and would potentially place equipment on an existing tower in that area which could save the project roughly \$7,000. Fire Chief Keith Horan arrived at 7:38 PM. Chief Horan had brought items for discussion in regard to filling public swimming pool request for the upcoming year(s), repairs to the East Fire Station building, HVAC system being placed into the East Fire Station, along with the House Numbering issues within the community. The Library Director received a wage increase at their last board meeting. Public Works Director Alesch presented to the council updates on the Ballfield repairs, asking for additional hired seasonal help, Water Treatment Facility/ 2nd St Water Main, as well as our House Numbering issues.
