

RESOLUTION NO. 24-08

RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE MANDATORY EMERGENCY WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES FOR USERS  
OF THE EARLY WATER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, an equipment failure has occurred within the City's water supply has become significantly and seriously depleted so that there may not be a significant supply of water to meet all customary and usual demands.

WHEREAS, under these conditions the council will declare a Water Warning Tier II.

WHEREAS, Water Warning- Tier II. Under a Tier II Water Warning, no person shall use potable processed water of the municipal water service in any manner contrary to the following:

- A) All outside water use, except for domestic, sanitation, and fire is prohibited.
- B) All commercial and industrial uses of water not essential in providing products or services are prohibited.
- C) Agricultural crops is prohibited.
- D) Recreational and leisure water use; including lawn and golf course: watering and other incidental or recreational use is prohibited.
- E) Water use not necessary for the preservation of life or the general welfare of the community is prohibited.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EARLY, IOWA:

Section 1. A Water Warning Tier 2 has been declared due to equipment failure which poses a serious threat to meet the needs of its customers currently and in the foreseeable future.
